# **Community Investment Campaign**



We are nearing the end of our Community Investment Campaign on October 15th. We expect to have raised nearly \$1 million by the end of this week, mostly from our owner-members! We're still looking for more investment to reach our \$1.75 mil goal.

These community investments will help fund construction, hire staff, purchase equipment, and stock the shelves to get

the store up and going. This unique funding structure let's us rely less on bank loans, bolstering our financial resiliency and personal pride!

Did you know that even non-owner-members can purchase Preferred Shares (of stock) that could *pay you* dividends up to 5%?

If you live in Illinois- you are eligible to purchase up to 10 of these shares to help yourself, and *help us* raise the funds needed to build our community-owned grocery store.

But wait, there's more! if you pledge to purchase preferred shares by **TOMORROW** at midnight the impact of your purchase will be *doubled*. A generous owner-member has pledged \$100,000 to *match all pledges* made by midnight on Wednesday, October 6th.

We need owners and non-owners, like you, to ACT NOW and make a pledge. It is very easy to fill out our short online pledge

Food Shed: What is the one thing about our community-owned grocery store that excites you the most?

SB: The **community** part of that sentence resonates the most for us. The coop will be yet another place for people to come together and be in community to enjoy and celebrate each other. At the end of the day, we all want to live in a vibrant, healthy, and interesting place where we can take care of our families and teach our children well.

Food Shed: How did you find out about the Food Shed Co-op and when did you join as an owner?

SB: Kim likes to say that the idea was born on our front porch around 2012. In fact we had discussed elements of having a co-op for years with friends like Marcia Johnson (also a former board member). After being impressed with co-ops we had shopped in around the country, we kept asking the question, why not here? In 2013 I was laid off from my job. No longer did I have an excuse to not be in action to do something positive for the community, i.e., think global and act local. I started calling some local farmers and activists like Sue Rekenthaler and Keith Johnson of the Woodstock Farmers Market and pretty soon we had a steering committee. I met Doug Close for the first time and

what a gift he has been to the co-op! Kim and I are touched, moved and inspired by the owner growth that has happened since our modest beginnings. The idea that a few people who had a few conversations in 2013 has now led to over 1250 households giving their money to become owners, and more recently investing even more to build this store, is incredible.

After eight years, the Food Shed has become part of our personal story and our life's work. It has been a joyful and gratifying experience to be involved in something bigger than ourselves which is so worthwhile.
