What is Your Food In? by Emily Zack

We all pay attention to what we eat. We read the ingredient list and look at the nutritional facts. We know where it is made and how far it traveled. But what about the packaging? We know to recycle the cardboard and bring the plastic bags back to the store to recycle. We are also very aware that much of the plastic we use is not recycled so we bring our own cloth, reusable bags to



the grocery store. But as we shop, most of what we buy is in plastic. Bulk containers of nuts and dried fruit, bags for donuts and cookies, bags in the produce section and plastic clamshells at the salad bar. Wouldn't it be nice to shop at a store where we aren't surrounded by all that non-recyclable plastic? This is one of the things the Food Shed is working hard at accomplishing. We are looking at cellophane bags for baked goods and bulk items that are made from FSC-certified wood-cellulose-derived bioplastic which are compostable, vegan, and non-GMO. Coffee bags that are completely compostable—even the valve and zipper. We found compostable labels and stickers, so you don't even have to peel them off to compost! There are food safe containers for cold items made from US grown corn and wheat straw. The wheat straw is from what is left over from the wheat stalk and is gluten free and has no allergens. Coffee cups and to-go boxes made from 100% post-consumer recycled paper; even the ones that are PLA-lined are compostable. Soup bowls made from a renewable fiber that is a byproduct of sugarcane farming using the leftover sugarcane stalks. Produce bags made from processing the natural cellulose fibers of plants that will compost in your backyard compost bin. Bamboo is

very fast growing and used to make all kinds of items including toilet paper and paper towels, much more sustainable than trees. We at the Food Shed are taking every part of your shopping experience very seriously, even the garbage by eliminating as much plastic as we can. We can't wait to show you!
