Fairtrade by Peter Waldmann

Walking through the aisles in your local grocery store, you may have noticed this Fairtrade label on several items; coffee and bananas are the most common. So, what does the Fairtrade label mean?

Fairtrade certification is a way of guaranteeing that both buyers and sellers stick to the principles of Fairtrade. Different organizations certify Fairtrade products, each with its label and standards.



Fairtrade farmers promise to pay a fair wage to all their workers, are required to provide safe and healthy working conditions, and use sustainable growing practices that protect natural resources, including water, soil, and natural vegetation.

To use the Fair-Trade label, products must meet the standards of the certifying organization, some of which are:

- Transparency: All terms and conditions of Fairtrade transactions are detailed in contracts signed by the producers and buyers.
- Fair price: Producers receive at least a Fairtrade Minimum Price, which aims at covering the average costs of sustainable production, or the market price, whichever is higher.

- Trading with integrity: Operators along the Fairtrade supply chains do not engage in unfair trading practices.
- Labor and environment: Fairtrade supply chain tradespeople comply with labor and environmental law.
