

We Will Strive to Be a Model for McHenry County

Last month the Food Shed Co-op team had the opportunity to attend two Earth Day Events in McHenry County: Earth Day at Prairieview Education Center and the Green Living Fair at Ridgefield Presbyterian Church. We are grateful to community leaders for coordinating the events and spotlighting environmental responsibility and best practices.

The Food Shed Co-op intends to be a model for McHenry County businesses. Among our core values is to champion environmentally responsible practices. So far, our business environmental initiatives include solar panels, car charging stations, bioswales, bike



path, native pollinating gardens, in-store recycling, in-store composting, strict single-use plastic restrictions, and package-free Bulk Food categories. In addition, every department will have reclamation tactics and procedures to reduce food waste.

We are thrilled that over 1660 local residents believed in us enough to become Food Shed Co-op owners. Many of those owners have gone beyond and become investors, as well. To learn more or to become an owner yourself, please visit the **Food Shed Coop website**.

Collaborating with Local Farmers

The Food Shed Co-op is looking forward to working with and developing new relationships with local farmers and producers. That is going to be the heart of our store. We have such richness of soil, growers, talent and diversity here in McHenry County.

We are already working with a handful of dedicated and passionate farmers through a variety of fundraising efforts to support the Food Shed Co-op. One of those is Ramshackle Farm, a queer and trans owned anti-capitalist, punk rock farm that has



been in operation since 2021. They operate a year round farm, growing hydroponically, in high tunnels, and in a diversified no-till market garden to offer local, pesticide free food to our community throughout the year. They are excited about building community, and supporting a resilient, accessible local food system. They prioritize queer joy on their farm and aim to craft a safe space for LGBTQIA+ folks within the landscape of rural agriculture.

We, as the Food Shed Co-op, continue sharing information about the unique mission of our grocery store every chance we get. Co-op staff and volunteers get out into the public at Farmers Markets and a variety of community events to share information and answer questions. Our General Manager, Peter Waldmann, and Outreach Director, Sue Jensen, have spoken to small groups throughout the county describing features that will set the Food Shed Co-op apart from other grocery stores. The biggest difference is that our store will help keep money circulating within our community rather than it going off to shareholders of a big corporation. Other unique qualities of the store will be its focus on stocking healthy, locally sourced goods and produce items, having a fantastic prepared foods kitchen and our commitment to sustainable practices.
